

Use Your Senses to Detect Natural Gas



Oklahoma Natural Gas is focused on providing safe and reliable natural gas service to your home and business. You can play a part in natural gas safety, too. Find out how you can use your senses to recognize the signs of a potential natural gas leak.



How to Recognize a Natural Gas Leak

- LOOK: If you're near a natural gas pipeline and you see dirt or water blowing in the air or continuous bubbling from standing water, this could be a sign of a leak.
- **LISTEN:** Do you hear a hissing or roaring sound near a pipeline? This may be an indication of a leak.
- **SMELL:** An additive called mercaptan is used to give natural gas its distinct sulfur- or rotten-egg-like odor. This pungent smell is a warning sign of a possible leak.
- **CALL:** If you suspect a natural gas leak, **leave the area** and avoid doing anything that could create a spark. Warn others to stay away and then immediately call 911 or Oklahoma Natural Gas at 1-800-458-4251.

Your bills will fluctuate slightly each month; however, the change should be modest since it will be based upon actual costs over a 12-month period.

Once enrolled, your natural gas bill payment will be automatically deducted from your bank account on your due date each month. Tasty Bacon Brussels Sprouts

Ingredients:

6 slices bacon
1/2 cup sliced white or yellow onion
1 1/2 pounds Brussels sprouts,
trimmed and halved
8 garlic cloves, thinly sliced
3/4 cup fat-free, low-sodium
vegetable broth
Salt
Pepper

Directions:

- 1. Heat a large nonstick skillet over medium-high natural gas flame.
- Add bacon and sauté for 5 minutes or until bacon begins to brown. Remove the bacon from skillet and chop into small pieces.
- 3. In skillet, stir in bacon, onion and Brussels sprouts; sauté 4 minutes. Add garlic and sauté for 4 minutes or until garlic begins to brown, stirring frequently.

Add the vegetable broth and bring to a boil. Cook for 2 minutes, stirring occasionally.

5. Remove from heat; stir in salt and pepper.
