

Save Money, Stay Green with Oklahoma Natural Gas' CNG Rebate Program



Compressed natural gas, or CNG, is a cleaner, greener alternative vehicle fuel, and we at Oklahoma Natural Gas want you to see the benefits of CNG. Natural gas vehicles produce significantly fewer pollutants than gasoline vehicles and have little to no emissions during fueling. According to the U.S. Department of Energy, using vehicles that run on natural gas instead of gasoline can reduce smog-producing gases, such as carbon monoxide and nitrogen oxides, by more than 90 percent and 60 percent, respectively.

Oklahoma Natural offers a generous CNG rebate program. Through this program, Oklahoma residents can receive rebates for the purchase of a natural gas vehicle and home refueling station. Some restrictions apply; see application for details. The Oklahoma Natural Gas CNG Rebate Program offers the following rebates:

Dedicated natural gas vehicle \$2,000 rebate	
Bi-fueled natural gas vehicle\$2,000 rebate	
Residential CNG fueling system \$3,000 rebate	



Your savings can go even further with these incentives offered by state and federal governments*:

- 45 percent tax credit from the State of Oklahoma for the purchase of a CNG vehicle.
- 50 percent (up to \$2,500) tax credit from the State of Oklahoma for a home refueling appliance.
- \$1,000 federal tax credit for a home refueling appliance (available for 2016 only).

Paying Made Easy

Oklahoma Natural Gas is all about convenience, which is why we offer several ways to pay your bill. In addition to paying online, by mail or by phone, you may use the following methods to make your monthly payment:

Mobile App – You can now pay bills, view payment history and more from the convenience of your smartphone. Find our app in both Apple® and Android® app stores by searching "Oklahoma Natural Gas." You must have an Oklahoma Natural Gas online account in order to gain account access using the mobile app. You may register for an online account at www.oklahomanaturalgas.com.

> Pay Agents – You can make payments by check, money order or cash. An agent will help you and provide a receipt. Pay agents do not have access to our billing system, and a fee may be assessed by the pay agent.

Kiosks – Similar to an ATM, a kiosk allows for payment by cash or check. Customers must have their bill stubs. A receipt is provided and, because no change is given, any overpayment is credited to the account. A fee is assessed by the kiosk provider.

Bacon-Wrapped Asparagus

Ingredients:

21 asparagus stalks 7 thick-cut bacon slices 1 tablespoon olive oil ¼ teaspoon garlic powder ¼ teaspoon onion powder ½ teaspoon seasoned salt Pepper to taste

Directions:

1. Preheat your natural gas oven to 425° F.

Bundle together 3 stalks of asparagus and wrap with a piece of bacon. Arrange on a rimmed baking sheet and repeat until all asparagus has been wrapped with bacon.
Whisk together oil, garlic powder, onion powder, salt and pepper and pour over asparagus bundles.

4. Bake for about 15 minutes until asparagus and bacon are done. Remove from the oven and serve.
