

THE 411 ON 811

As the weather gets warmer, many of us will head outside to complete those outdoor projects we've been planning all winter. But if any of them involve digging, there's an important call you need to make before you start - a call to 811.





A call to 811 will alert owners of utilities, pipelines, telecommunication cables and power lines to mark their buried utilities. There's no charge to you for this service.



Whether you're planting a tree or garden, installing a deck or setting fence posts, always remember to call 811 at least 48 hours (excluding the day of notification, weekends and holidays) before you dig to allow utility line locations to be marked.

So, during National Safe Digging Month, and any time of year, be safe and make sure to call 811 before you dig. It's free and it's the law! You may also submit a locate request online by visiting Okie811.org.

CRISPY BAKED CHICKEN

Ingredients

- ¾ cup mayonnaise
- ½ cup grated Parmesan cheese
- ¾ teaspoon garlic powder
- ¾ cup Italian seasoned bread crumbs
- 4 skinless, boneless chicken breast halves

Directions

- Preheat your natural gas oven to 425 degrees.
- In a bowl, mix mayonnaise, Parmesan cheese, and garlic powder. Place bread crumbs in a separate bowl. Dip chicken into the mayonnaise mixture, then into the bread crumbs to coat. Arrange coated chicken on a baking sheet.
- 3. Bake for 20 minutes, or until juices run clear and outside is golden brown.
