# Natural Gas: The Cleaner, Greener Fuel

When you use natural gas, you're making a responsible choice for the environment. That's because natural gas is the cleanest-burning fossil fuel, and homes that use natural gas instead of electricity for cooking, clothes drying and space and water heating can reduce their carbon footprint by up to 30 percent.



Natural gas is an efficient choice, too. Ninety-two percent of natural gas is delivered to your home as energy, compared with only 32 percent for electricity. Less energy lost during delivery means less waste, and that's good news for the environment.

But that's not the only good news: natural gas benefits your budget, too. Households that use natural gas appliances for heating, water heating, cooking and clothes drying spend an average of \$653 less per year than homes using electric appliances.

Next time you take a hot shower or light that blue flame on your natural gas range, you can feel good knowing it's fueled by the cleaner, more affordable fuel.

### Garlic Parmesan Oven Roasted Cauliflower

### Ingredients:

- 1 head of cauliflower, cut in half
- 3 tbsp. olive oil
- 4 garlic cloves
- 3 tbsp. grated parmesan cheese ½ tsp. herb seasoning of your choice Salt and pepper to taste

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Preheat natural gas oven to 400 degrees.
- 2. Cut cauliflower head in half and stuff two garlic cloves in each half.
- 3. In a medium bowl, mix together olive oil, parmesan cheese, herb seasoning and salt and pepper. Toss together and pour over cauliflower.
- 4. Place on a baking sheet coated with cooking spray.
- 5. Bake for 30-40 minutes. Let cool and cut into florets.

Serves 4.
