## **Rebates Available for You!**



for the construction of a new home served by and connected to Oklahoma Natural Gas\*



for the installation of a natural gas clothes dryer outlet.



\*Needs to meet the following guidelines:

#### New Homes 2,000 sq ft and above must contain:

Primary Heat Source of 92% or greater Annual Fuel Utilization Efficiency (AFUE) natural gas heating / Primary natural gas water heating / One other installed natural gas appliance / A minimum of one additional natural gas outlet (for a total of four)

#### New Homes below 2,000 sq ft must contain:

Primary heat source of 92% or greater AFUE natural gas heating / Primary natural gas water heating / A minimum of one additional natural gas outlet (for a total of three connections)

#### **Eligibility**

- Incentive is for newly built, individually metered residential homes.
- Construction practices must be consistent with the guidelines for energy efficiency set by the 2009 international Energy Conservation Code (IECC) plus Energy Star rated windows and slab insulation.
- To receive the \$100 rebate, you must first qualify for the \$750 rebate.

#### **Important Information**

Oklahoma Natural Gas reserves the right to disallow ratings by a third party. Rebates may be available to any Oklahoma Natural Gas current or prospective customer. Customer must have active account at the location of the new, individually metered residential home. Only qualified natural gas equipment will be considered for a rebate. Oklahoma Natural Gas encourages each customer to review all program eligibility requirements.

Rebate checks will be mailed approximately six to eight weeks after approval, subject to availability of program funds. Completed applications will be reviewed and processed by Oklahoma Natural Gas on a first-come, first-served basis until program funds are depleted.

# How to Get Your Rebate

- Contact a certified Residential Energy Services Network (RESNET) Home Energy Rater, approved by Oklahoma Natural Gas, prior to installation of sheet rock.
- 2. All Inspections (thermal bypass and final inspection) will be performed by the certified RESNET Home Energy Rater.
- 3. The Following must be submitted to Oklahoma Natural Gas within 180 days following final inspection:
  - Completed rebate application
  - First inspection (thermal bypass)
  - Home Energy Rater's final invoice
  - Certified RESNET Home Energy Rating Certificate (must have a HERS Index Rating of 70 or less)
- 4. Please submit all required documentation listed in item 3 to <u>ongnewhome@onegas.com</u> for review.
