



Dear Customer:

Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, a division of ONE Gas, Inc. previously provided notice of its Application filed with the Oklahoma Corporation Commission in Cause No. PUD 202200023 requesting review and approval of its calculations under the Performance Based Rate Change Plan. This Supplemental Notice pertains to the same Application and is provided to inform you of a postponement to the date when the Commission will conduct a hearing on the Application. This postponement will allow additional time to provide public comment.

Public comment will be received at the previously noticed hearing on August 4, 2022, at 9:30 a.m. in Courtroom 301, at the Jim Thorpe Office Building, 2101 N. Lincoln Blvd., Oklahoma City, Oklahoma and at this same time via Zoom at <https://www.zoomgov.com/j/1610504725>. Following public comment, the hearing will be continued to September 29, 2022. Public comment on these matters also will be heard and received by the Corporation Commission's Administrative Law Judge at 9:30 a.m. on September 29, 2022, in Courtroom 301, at the Jim Thorpe Office Building, 2101 N. Lincoln Blvd., Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. All interested persons may appear and provide comments at that time. Public comment may also be given at this same time via Zoom at <https://www.zoomgov.com/j/1610504725>.

After public comment concludes on September 29, 2022, the evidentiary portion of the hearing will begin and continue on each subsequent business day as necessary for testimony and examination of the parties' witnesses. After the hearing, the Commission will issue such orders and grant such relief as it deems proper, necessary, fair, just and reasonable, whether or not specifically requested in the Application.

In addition to all of the above, members of the public may submit written comments by mail to the Clerk, Oklahoma Corporation Commission, 2101 N. Lincoln Blvd., Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, 73105, or by email to CS@occ.ok.gov. Written comments should be titled as "Public Comment" and clearly reference "PUD 202200023."

If you have previously submitted written comments in this Cause, or if you have given public comment to the Commission in prior hearings in this matter, your prior comments will be included in the record for consideration, and you are not required to re-submit those comments.

You are, however, free to submit additional comments using any method described above. As previously noticed, Oklahoma Natural Gas is seeking an increase of approximately \$19,668,043 in base rates. The requested increase is necessary to recover increased business costs and natural gas infrastructure investments. Oklahoma Natural Gas invested approximately \$119 million since its last base rate increase, a general rate review with a test year ending December 31, 2020. In addition, the company is requesting approval of the energy efficiency true-up and utility incentive adjustments for program year 2021 and modifications to its tariffs. The proposed increase would raise an average residential customer's service charge by approximately \$1.95 monthly or \$23.40 annually.

Additionally, as part of its compliance with the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017, Oklahoma Natural Gas will continue to return to customers excess deferred income taxes ("EDIT"), both protected and unprotected. The one-time annual EDIT credit for 2022 is \$9,129,977, subject to true-up. This EDIT credit equates to a one-time \$9.43 credit for an average residential customer. The one-time annual EDIT credit for 2022 will be paid in February 2023. This credit is separate and in addition to the requested increase described above.

In consideration of the requested base rate increase, the proposed adjustment to reflect the energy efficiency true-up and utility incentive calculations for program year 2021, and the one-time EDIT credit for 2022, the increase in the annual bill for an average residential customer is \$13.97, or \$1.16 per month.
